From the President: Hello Club members,

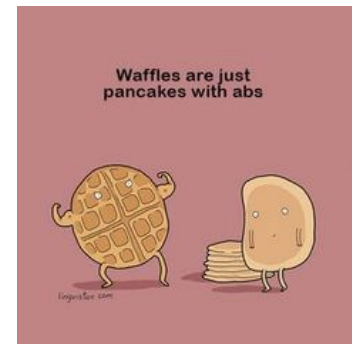
